

Dear Patient,

Thank you for registering to receive your COVID vaccine.

If you are receiving the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine, they require 2 doses.

- The second dose for the Pfizer vaccine will be given 3 weeks after the 1st dose
 - Unless otherwise notified, your second dose will be scheduled for the same time as your first dose
- The second dose for the Moderna vaccine will be given 4 weeks after the 1st dose
 - Unless otherwise notified, your second dose will be scheduled for the same time as your first dose

It is important that you receive both doses of the vaccine to receive the full benefit.

The vaccine will be given in the muscle of your upper arm, so please wear clothes that will allow easy access to your upper arm.

It is important to know that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommend that you wait at least 14 days between the COVID-19 vaccine and another vaccine. Please discuss any questions or concerns about vaccination with your healthcare provider.

Wooster Community Hospital is providing the COVID-19 vaccine for no cost to our community. However, if you have insurance, Wooster Community Hospital will bill your insurance provider for the cost to administer the vaccine. You will not be billed for any balance, deductible, copay or coinsurance.

When you arrive for your appointment:

- Please arrive on time and use the Outpatient Pavilion Entrance.
 - This entrance is located off of Beall Avenue behind Pizza Hut
 - There will be some reserved parking spaces but you may park wherever there is an available spot
- Please Bring with you:
 - Your Driver's License or State ID
 - Your Insurance Card
 - Please bring a signed copy of the consent form if you have already filled out this information. (if you were unable to access the consent form, paperwork will be provided at the clinic)
